

IOptima (Subsidiary) : First sale of the IOptiMate™ System in Belarus ; Material Sales of the LIPITEAR™ product during Q2/18

Tel Aviv (June 24, 2018) – BioLight is pleased to announce that today, its subsidiary IOptima Ltd., ("**IOptima**")¹, announced first sale of its IOptiMate™ System in Belarus to a hospital in said territory. The sale was carried out through IOptima's local distributor in Belarus, with which an exclusive distribution agreement was signed and after the recent receipt of the required regulatory certificate from the Health Ministry in Belarus.

This report is published in accordance with BioLight's policy regarding the publication of reports on each first sale of the IOptiMate™ System in a new territory.

In addition, IOptima updated BioLight that since the beginning of the second quarter of 2018, and until today, the LIPITEAR™ product² was sold, for the first time, for a total substantial amount of over NIS 450 thousand.
